(PDV), Robert Burkhardt of PDV, Dr. Arif Ansari of AMT Inc., a technical advisor to EWA/PDV, and undersigned counsel met with the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and Office of Engineering and Technology staff listed below. The attendees discussed the following issues with regard to the above-identified proceeding:
