Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 6, 2026, Robin Cohen, President and CEO of the Enterprise Wireless Alliance (“EWA”) and EWA’s undersigned regulatory counsel met in person with Arpan Sura, Senior Counsel and Chief AI Officer in the office of Chairman Brendan Carr. The EWA representatives explained the importance to the American economy of the private land mobile radio (“PLMR”) users EWA represents and described their use of spectrum in their private wireless systems. They recommended FCC action on the EWA/National Wireless Communications Council proposal to put to use promptly recovered, long-dormant narrowband and wideband auctioned spectrum in FCC inventory. Those parties have proposed adopting a proven frequency coordination process that allows the assignment of this spectrum to qualified applicants, while avoiding the filing of mutually exclusive applications with the FCC. The EWA representatives also explained the deregulatory objectives of their two pending Petitions for Rulemaking (“Petitions”) identified above as detailed in the Petitions and in EWA’s comments on them. Finally, the EWA representatives addressed the Wireless Telecommunication Bureau policy regarding the regulatory status of non-interconnected Specialized Mobile Radio licenses in light of Section 332 of the Communications Act.
