Dear Ms. Dortch:

The Enterprise Wireless Alliance (“EWA”) understands from Chairman Carr’s blog today that the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) expects to adopt a Report and Order (“R&O”) in the above-identified proceeding at its February agenda meeting. EWA was one of the initial proponents of rule changes to make the original 3/3 megahertz 900 MHz broadband opportunity available for enterprise entities and was a signatory on the proposal to allow the further 5/5 megahertz option. It has always encouraged the land mobile community to embrace advanced technologies that offer greater spectrum efficiency and more advanced capabilities. It has worked to help clear the spectrum for broadband use and has assisted utilities that have taken advantage of the 3/3 megahertz option.

EWA looks forward to reviewing the draft R&O when it is released tomorrow. It is confident it will be consistent with the Chairman’s commitment to ensuring spectrum is being deployed to provide vital services to the American public. An Order that strikes the right balance between protecting the rights of incumbents while promoting broadband access for all critical industries, including utilities, will serve the interests of those affected by this forward-thinking decision. The fact that the rules governing 900 MHz broadband also mean the public, through the US Treasury, is receiving fair compensation for spectrum previously held in FCC inventory is a double win for the United States.


