
On July 30, 2015, Mark Crosby, President/CEO of the Enterprise Wireless Alliance (EWA), Morgan O'Brien, Vice-Chairman of Pacific DataVision, Inc. (PDV), Robert Burkhardt of PDV, Dr. Arif Ansari of AMT Inc., a technical advisor to EWA/PDV, and undersigned counsel met with the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and Office of Engineering and Technology staff listed below. The attendees discussed the following issues with regard to the above-identified proceeding:

- The respective rights and obligations of licensees in adjacent allocations when considering a proposed transition of spectrum from narrowband to broadband use. PDV summarized certain technical issues detailed in its filings in the proceeding, including its use of improved filtering techniques to protect adjacent operations.
- PDV's position that more specific information is needed with regard to the "near real time" operations of certain Sensus customers as raised in recent Sensus filings before appropriate interference protection criteria can be considered.
- The priority access opportunity proposed for Critical Infrastructure Industry entities.
