Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 26, 2022, representatives of American Petroleum Institute, Enterprise Wireless Alliance, Forestry Conservation Communications Association, National Sheriffs' Association, and Utilities Technology Council had a telephone conference with Ethan Lucarelli of Chairwoman Rosenworcel's office to discuss their August 25, 2022, joint *ex parte* letter proposing a framework for establishing a single entity with nationwide spectrum management responsibility for the 4.9 GHz band. The representatives expressed their interest in working with the Commission in finalizing rules that would promote more intensive use of this spectrum for multiple use cases such as fixed, mobile, microwave, robotics, WiFi, UAS, and other technologies. They were advised that the Chairwoman understood the need for a national manager and hoped to take further steps in the proceeding in the near-term future.
